#### **Commission on Judicial Nominees Evaluation 2024 Statewide Demographics Report**

Government Code section 12011.5 (n)(1)(B) requires that on or before March 1, the Commission on Judicial Nominees Evaluation (JNE) collect and release aggregate, statewide data on the following: (1) demographic data "provided by all judicial applicants reviewed relative to ethnicity, race, disability, veteran status, gender, gender identity, sexual orientation, and areas of legal practice and employment"; and (2) a summary of JNE Commission recommendations by the same categories.

Consistent with statutory intent, the 2024 report includes data for the 185 candidates whose qualifications for judicial office were reviewed in the 2024 calendar year.
